We now have a **Kit for Emergency Low Blood Sugar Assistance** located at the back of the church, near the AED. Signs and symptoms of low blood sugar can include weakness, sweating, confusion, shaking and hunger. The “fast sugar” items, such as juice and candies, should be used first, followed by the “longer acting” cheese and crackers package.
