Renovation Committee Report

The Renovation Committee had an **informal** meeting with Jonathan Flagg, the Williamsburg Building Inspector, Russ Sprague, the Diocesan Director of Building & Grounds, and Ray Casella of Casella Design Associates.

The purpose of the meeting was to ask Jonathan his opinion on what the committee should focus on first as we begin our 5-year plan of renovating our church. At the meeting, Jonathan expressed that we should focus on addressing the church's Life Safety concerns. He recommended we begin by upgrading or replacing our Fire Alarm System.

A fire alarm system warns people when smoke, fire, carbon monoxide or other fire-related emergencies are detected. These alarms may be activated automatically from smoke detectors, and heat detectors or may also be activated via manual fire alarm activation devices such as manual call points or pull stations. This system will also notify the Fire Department automatically when the fire alarm system is activated.

The Committee agreed with this recommendation. We will be working with Russ and Ray on our next steps.

The Renovation Committee will provide updates as new information becomes available.
