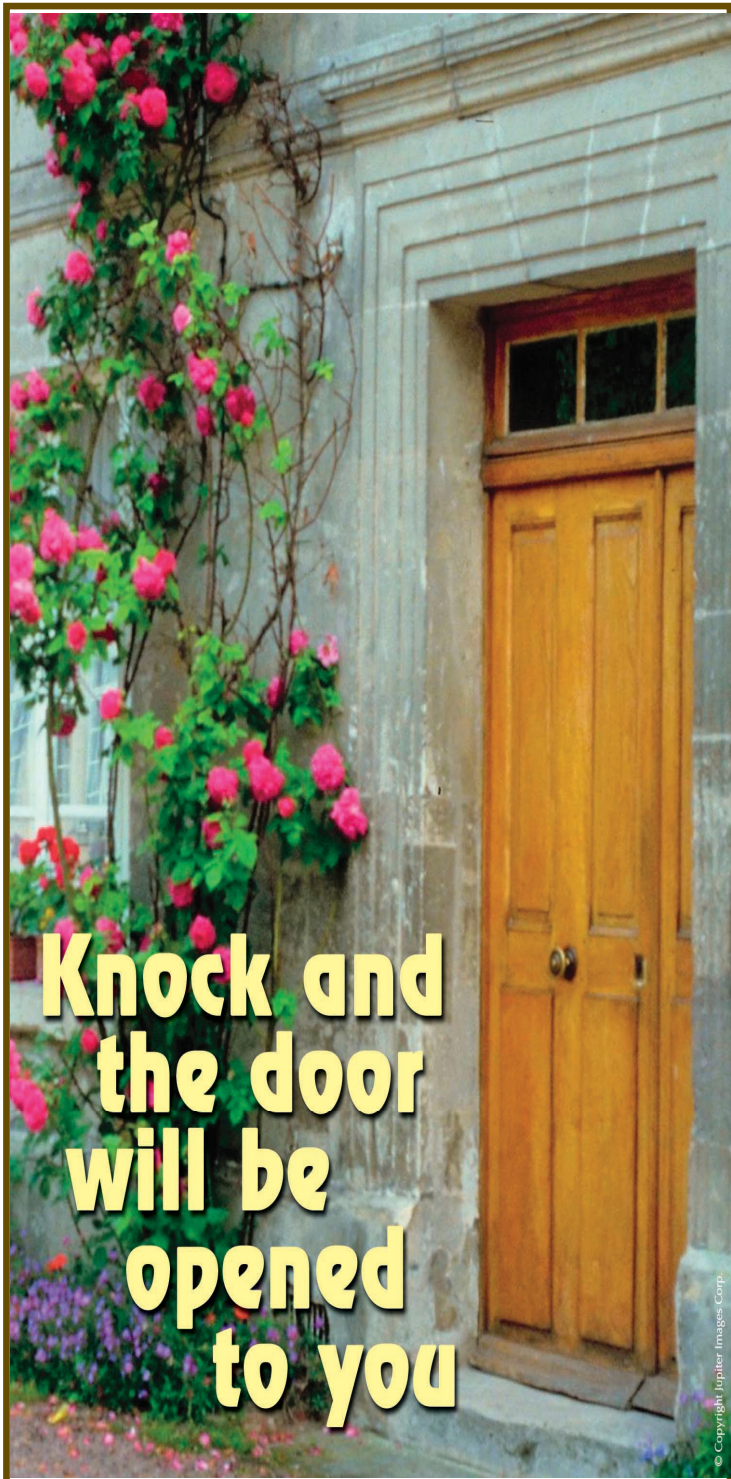

Bethlehem House is a non-profit, faith-based organization which offers free pregnancy resources for women in crisis. They reach out to provide non-judgmental, compassionate support to all members of the family, including single dads. They offer many services including gifts of baby supplies and other necessities which are provided until the child is 18 months old.

We, as a parish, will be able to help in these efforts through our donations. There will be a donation basket in the back of the church (in place of baby bottles which they do not use at this time). Donations of cash, checks (to Bethlehem House, Inc.), or gift cards to Walmart or grocery stores which the director can use to purchase needed items are always welcome. There will also be a bassinet set up for donations of clothing, diapers, etc, Bethlehem House is compiling a list of specific needs, specific diapers and clothing sizes and these will be presented in our upcoming bulletins.
